Rustlers kill vigilante, cart away Bishop Kwashi's cattle

The police yesterday said it received information that suspected cattle rustlers invaded the ranch of the Archbishop of the Anglican Diocese of Jos, Bishop Benjamin Kwashi and rustled nine cattle.

corpse has been deposited at the Jos University Teaching Hospital.

A statement issued by state's Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Tyopev Terna, said investigation was on-going to track and arrest the suspects.

Kwashi, on Sunday morning wrote on his Facebook wall that the rustlers broke into his ranch between 6pm and 6am while the curfew was in place.

He stated that, "for the third time in my home, we were raided last night and cows taken awayand there was curfew!!! We are not safe in homes, I am raising an alarm today if the government will listen ...we are not safe!!! Is the curfew for some and not others? Lord in your mercy..."




