4 die as vehicle plunges into river

Four people died yesterday as a Toyota Siena plunged into Ovia River in the Ovia North-East Local Government Area of Edo State.

It was gathered that the accident happened

at Ofosu Bridge, about 35 kilometres from Ore.

The state sector commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Anthony Oko, who confirmed the accident, said four people died while one injured in the accident.

He attributed the accident to speed limit violation by the motorists, adding that five people were involved in the lone accident.

Oko said the victims were taken to Ago Itunu Hospital at Ofosu area.
