## 3 killed in Plateau attack

At least three people were killed on Sunday in Kwata area of Jos South Local Government Area of Plateau State. The victims are a pregnant woman, a commercial motorcyclist and a man.

This was barely two days after two herders were killed in Kuru district of the same local government area. The state chapter of the Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigeria said those killed were Fulani.

Its chairman, Muhammad Nuru Abdullahi, said: "The DPO of (B) division in Bukuru is much aware of everything. The state commissioner of police is also aware of the incident because we have spoken about the incident and asked me to calm down.

"They were all killed on Sunday, but the bodies were recovered on Monday. Among them include a pregnant woman and two men," he said.

Abdullahi alleged that the attackers were Beron youths. But the spokesperson of Berom Community, Davou Jatau, denied the allegation, saying the incident was "purely an act of criminality."

Police Public Relations OfficerDSP Tyopev Terna, said he was not aware of the incident and promised to get back to our reporter but he never did.
