6 soldiers injured in Boko Haram attack

The Nigerian Army said that six soldiers sustained injury while repelling Boko Haram insurgents in an ambush at Arege area of Borno on Friday.

Brig.-Gen. Texas Chukwu, Army Director, Public Relations, announced this in a statement he issued in Maiduguri, yesterday.

He said that scores of the insurgents were neutralised while others escaped with various degrees of injury during the encounter.

Chukwu said one vehicle was recovered from the terrorists, while three gun trucks were destroyed by the troops of Sector 3, deployed in Operation Lafiya Dole.
