
Insurgents kill 11 farmers, beat women in Borno

Suspected Boko Haram insurgents Monday killed at least 11 farmers and beat their wives in two attacks on Jere Local Government Area of Borno State.

Aisha Usman, whose husband was slaughtered in her presence, narrated:

"We were working on our farm when we sighted some people advancing

towards us, then we began to run, they ran after us, they gathered us in one

place and separated our husbands from us before they slaughtered them; they

forcefully collected their phones and money.

"They killed 10 men, including my husband, they went away with their bicycles,

they beat us mercilessly, also, they collected our phones and money too. I

don't know what to do, just look at my children, how could I cater for their

needs, I am having five children what do I do now?"

Mamannti farmers was inhuman, we were informed that Boko Haram killed

about 10 and their wives were seriously beaten. We have informed the military

about it."
