## Birthday party killing: Police parade 'principal' suspect

The police in Bauchi have paraded a man said to be the principal suspect in the crisis that occurred at Yelwa area, a suburb of the metropolis.

Parading the suspect, the state command's spokesman, DSP Kamal Datti Abubakar, said operatives attached to the State Intelligence Bureau (SIB) intercepted and arrested the suspect, Patrick Zumunta, on his way to Bauchi from Jos.

According to the police, a fight had broken out between two rival groups at a birthday party organised by the suspect for his girlfriend which led to the death of three people and burning of two houses and a car.

It could be recalled that 76 suspects were arrested by the police following the crisis at Yelwa Tsakani about two weeks ago.

DSP Abubakar, while fielding questions from journalists, said some of the suspects have already been charged to court while others were still being investigated.
