

Yobe military base attack: corpses of 9 soldiers found

Nine corpses of the soldiers killed by Boko Haram militants during the recent attack on the Buni Gari military base in Yobe State have been discovered, sources have revealed.

A security source said more soldiers were still missing, “Six soldiers were recovered as at Sunday after the attack. Today (Monday), we discovered two more making the total eight. Some of the soldiers are also MIA (missing in action)”.

It was also gathered that the military base, including the armoured personal carrier (APC), was set ablaze by the insurgents.

Sources at Damaturu Specialist Hospital also confirmed that the corpses of the nine soldiers had been deposited in the morgue.

“Six dead bodies of the soldiers were brought to the hospital on Sunday, while the other three were brought today (Yesterday),” one of the sources said.
