Hubby nabbed 6 months after allegedly killing wife

The Police in Jigawa State have arrested a murder suspect, who has reportedly been on the run for the past six months.

Shuaibu Haro, 30, allegedly killed his wife, Sahura Shuaibu, on June 25 in Bukki village of Dutse Local Government Area of the state.

The spokesman of the police in the state, SP Abdu Jinjiri, made the disclosure yesterday while parading the suspect in Dutse, saying, the suspect fled the scene of the crime after he had used a hoe to kill the diseased.

He explained that the remains of late Shuaibu, was recovered by the police on the fateful day at about 9pm in a bush in Bukki village.

"On June 25, a case of homicide was reported to the police in Fanisau Division that one Shuaibu Haro, aged 30 of Bukki village in Dutse LGA, had killed his wife, Sahura Shuaibu, aged 20, and fled after committing the crime.

"Upon a tip of, on December, 28, the police arrested the fleeing suspect, who has been on the run since June.

"The suspect used a hoe to hit his late wife severally on the head which led to her death. Investigation into the case has since commenced with a view to charging the suspect to court," Jinjiri said.
