

Fresh attack claims 3 in Jema'a

Three people were reported killed on Monday in a fresh attack by gunmen in Gerti village, Kaninkon Ward, Jama'a Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

The incident, according Christopher Yakubu Philip, the councillor, representing Kaninkon Ward, occurred at about 8:00am when the victims, including a man and his son were working on the farm.

He said as the victims were busy with their farm work, armed men suspected to be herdsmen open fire at them and killed three of them on the spot.

He said one person, however, escaped to the village to alert the community about the attack.

He said the community, led by soldiers, went to the farm to recover the corpses of the victims.

Philip said upon hearing news of the incident, other people who were in their farms were asked to return home to avoid been attacked.

When contacted, the spokesman of the state police command, DSP Yakubu Sabo, said he would get back to our reporter, but did not as of the time of filing this report.
