

Boko Haram kills 9 persons, 4 others missing

At least nine persons were killed including a humanitarian worker while one other person was wounded during an attack by members of the Boko Haram sect in Jere Local Government Area of Maiduguri, the Borno State capital, sources said.

The incident occurred at Moranti, a settlement opposite 333 Barracks near Tashan Joni area of Maiduguri at 0700hrs on Friday evening.

“Eight bodies were recovered while four are still missing. Members of the group attacked civilians working on the rail line at Moranti, a settlement, opposite 333 Barracks, near Tashan Joni general area of Maiduguri.

“Additionally, 1 recovered the body of an NGO worker but the organization has not spoken on it yet. One person is currently receiving treatment at the General Hospital, Maiduguri,” a vigilante source said.

A humanitarian worker said bodies of the victims were deposited at the state Specialist Hospital.

“They shot six civilians at about 5pm on Friday evening and in the early hours of Saturday, they came back to the same community and killed additional three persons”, he said.
