

B/Haram kills 10 fishermen, 2 others in Borno villages

Boko Haram insurgents were said to have killed 10 fishermen and two other civilians in Konduga Local Government Area of Borno State Saturday.

Local vigilante sources yesterday that the fishermen were killed at about 4.00pm at Ngawo Fate, near Alau Dam General, about 14 kilometer from Maiduguri.

The two other persons were said to have been killed at Dalori at 12 noon.

It was gathered that the vigilantes conveyed the bodies of the slain fishermen to the State Specialist Hospital in Maiduguri.

“The suspected Boko Haram killed some fishermen at Ngawo Fate near Alau Dam General area. It happened at about 1600hrs on Saturday. Vigilantes recovered 10 male bodies.

“Similarly, on the outskirts of Dalori, same Saturday at about 1200hours, insurgents well armed with rifles, shot dead two male civilians and rustled their cattle.

“It was unfortunate, but almost on a daily basis, they are killing our farmers, women and fishermen. People are no longer safe,” a vigilante source said.

A source at the State Specialist Hospital confirmed that some dead bodies were brought at the weekend.
