Man, 30, stabs own mother to death in Anambra

A 30-year-old man, Nwabueze Anakan, on Tuesday, stabbed his mother to death at Oraifite, Awka South Local Government Area of Anambra State and ran away, police have said.

Spokesman of the police in the state, Haruna Muhammed, in a statement, said the case was reported at Oraifite Division at about 12pm on Tuesday that earlier in the morning of the same date, Anaka allegedly stabbed his mother, Grace Anaka, 50, with a dagger and fled.

Muhammed said police detectives attached to the division visited the scene, and took the victim to hospital where she was certified dead by the medical doctor. Her corpse was deposited at the morgue.

"Circumstances surrounding the incident are yet to be ascertained but the complainants alleged that the suspect was having some mental challenges.

"The case is under investigation and effort is being intensified to apprehend the fleeing suspect in order to bring him to justice," the spokesman added.
