

Troops kill 1 bandit, destroy 2 camps in Kaduna

A combined troops of 1 Division, Nigerian Army Headquarters, Kaduna, under Operation Thunder Strike, Operation Whirl Punch and 312 Artillery Regiment, have killed one suspected bandit and destroyed two camps belonging to the criminals at Kankomi, close to Tantu and Daban Goje Mountains in Chikun Local Government Area of the state.

Deputy Director, Army Public Relations, 1 Division, Colonel Ezindu Idimah, in a statement yesterday said the operation was carried out between 2am and 4am on Sunday, following credible information from “well-meaning Nigerians”.

He further disclosed that one AK47 rifle, three motorcycles, two mobile phones and the sum of N5,000 were recovered.

“During the operation, the troops destroyed the two camps used by the bandits to perpetrate their nefarious activities. This is the fourth time within the last 10 days that the troops’ aggressive action has neutralised bandits and led to the recovery of arms and rescue of victims,” he said.
