Troops nuetralise top terrorists' commanders

The Armed Forces of Nigeria said troops of Operation Lafiya Dole conducted intelligence-based operations which continue to degrade Boko Haram /Islamic State of West Africa Province across the Theatre.

A statement on Sunday from the Coordinator, Defence Media Operations, Major General John Enenche said following credible intelligence, the gallant troops on 17 July targeted the terrorists on their market activities and undercover movement around Kolofata, a border town with Cameroon where troops of Strong Response Area (SRA) Pulka neutralized six Boko Haram terrorists attempting to cross from Cameroon Border towards Sambisa Axis.
