1 dead, four injured in Anambra auto crash

One person lost his life and four others sustained serious injuries in a fatal road accident that occurred in Ogbunka, Orumba South local government area of Anambra state.

The crash involved two vehicles, an Acura SUV with Lagos State registration number AKD-23-FB and a commercial bus also with Lagos State registration number-FST-857-XN.

An eye witness told Daily Trust that the vehicles had head-on collision leading to the death of a passenger in the bus while four others sustained varying degrees of injuries.

Confirming the accident, the image maker of Anambra State Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) Command Mr Edwin

Okadigbo, said that the driver of the Acura SUV was found drunk at the time of the accident.

"One person died and the body was deposited at Niger Hospital mortuary, Umunze, while four others sustained various degrees of injury and were taken to the same hospital.

"Preliminary investigation reveals drunkenness on the part of the SUV driver that resulted to loss of control.
