

Anambra road accident kills 1

Barely 24 hours after a commercial bus killed three persons along Enugu-Awka expressway at Amasea, Awka Anambra state, another road accident has claimed the life one person at Igwe Orizu junction Nnewi of the state.

Daily Trust gathered that the Yamaha Mate90 Motorcycle was hit by a Mercedes Benz Tipper, driven by unknown driver, who sped-off before being apprehended.

The image maker of Federal Roads safety Corps (FRSC) in the state, Pascal Anigbo, who confirmed the incident to journalists in Awka, on Sunday, said the fatal road traffic crash involving a Mercedes Benz Tipper and a Yamaha Mate90 Motorcycle both without registration number occurred at about 12.05pm on Sunday at Igwe Orizu Junction, along Nnewi-Otolo Road, Nnewi.

He said a total of three people were involved in the crash, all male adults, and unfortunately one person died, and others sustained injuries.

The injured victims were taken to Nnamdi Azikiwe Teaching Hospital, Nnewi, while bodies of the deceased have been deposited at Akwudo mortuary by the FRSC rescue team from Nnewi Unit Command.
