

Troops kill 105 terrorists in Yobe

Troops of Sector 2, Operation Lafiya Dole, on Saturday killed 105 Boko Haram/ISWAP terrorists at Buni Gari in Gujba Local Government Area of Yobe State.

This was disclosed yesterday by the Commander of the Operation, Brig.-Gen.

Lawrence Araba while briefing the Chief of Army Staff, Lt-Gen. Tukur Buratai and his entourage.

The terrorists were said to have attempted to infiltrate and attack Buni Gari Village.

Buratai applauded the troops for their gallantry and resilience that led to the killing of the 105 terrorists.

He gave the

commendation when he visited the injured troops at the Field Ambulance Logistics Base 3 Damaturu and Special Forces' School in Buni Yadi.

Buratai visited two officers that were wounded in action during the Buni Gari encounter and other soldiers already on admission at the medical

facility in Damaturu before proceeding to the Special Forces' School in Buni Yadi where he and his entourage were briefed on the incident by Brig.-Gen. Araba.

Araba said success was as a result of intelligence report which revealed the plan by the terrorists to attack the village.
