One person killed as OPC factional members clash in Osun

identified, in a chat with our correspondent, the young man who died in yesterday's clash as Bolaji Owolewa.

The clash, according to witnesses, started from an argument between a member of the Oodua Peoples Congress Initiative, Nurudeen Emiola, and a member of the Oodua Peoples Congress, Abiodun Ogunjimi.

The Osun State Commissioner of Police, Mr Undie Adie, confirmed the incident.
