B/Haram kill 35 in Borno

Boko Haram insurgents killed no fewer than 35 people and wounded several others when they attacked two local government areas of Borno State simultaneously, sources said yesterday.

It was learnt that the insurgents rode on utility vehicles to attack Usmanati Goni, Nganzai LGA at about 10:00 am yesterday, killing at least 38 people.

According to a top civilian JTF, the attackers burnt dozens of houses and took away livestock.

It would be recalled that fortnight ago insurgents attacked Gubio LGA where 81 civilians and hundreds of livestock were killed and six persons were abducted.
