

# Two killed in Ondo, hoodlums free 50 inmates

Despite the 24-hour curfew imposed on the state, two people were feared killed in Yaba, Ondo town, yesterday, as protesters continued in their protest while Governor Rotimi Akeredolu's campaign office was set ablaze

Also, a police station was set ablaze in Okitipupa and Okitipupa Correctional Centre was attacked where over 50 inmates were said to have escaped.

The lawmaker representing Ondo West constituency in the Ondo State House of Assembly,

Hon Tomide Akinribido, said he learnt from the police that one of those killed in Ondo was attempting to break into GTBank when he was shot and a gun was recovered from him.

The lawmaker also said another young man, identified as Ogunsakin Akinyemi, was shot in front of Crunchies Fast

Food, Ondo.

The hoodlums were also said to have attacked a local government secretariat and PHCH Office in the town.

The office of the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) also in Okitipupa was said to have been attacked and looted.

It was gathered that the youths had gathered in the morning to continue with their protest but security operatives moved in to enforce the curfew order. This was said to have angered the protesters in Okitipupa, who later regrouped and attacked the police station before moving to the correctional centre.
