Benue police arrest suspected killer of FUAM lecturer

The Police in Benue State yesterday said they have arrested one Nnamdi allegedly Jeremiah who was responsible for the killing of a lecturer with the Federal University of Agriculture, Makurdi (FUAM), Dr. Karl Kwaghger.

Daily Trust on Sunday reports that Kwaghger was murdered one week ago at a popular relaxation premises

in Makurdi metropolis.

Spokesperson of the Benue Police Command, DSP Catherine Anene, who confirmed the arrest in a statement issued in Makurdi, said the suspect is a student of FUAM and hails from Umigwe village in Imo State.

She said during the cause of investigation, the suspect was arrested in Abuja where he went to sell the car of the deceased lecturer after killing him.

"The suspect confessed to the crime and further stated that his initial intension was to threaten the victim with a make believe gun and rob him of his car but he ended up killing him because of his resistance and took the car away," she stated.

Anene added that investigation was still on into the matter and that the suspect will be charged to court

upon conclusion.
