The body of a revenue cashier, Joseph Myaan, who was abducted over one month ago in Katsina – Ala Local Government Council of Benue State, has been discovered in a shallow grave in Akpera suburb of Kastina-Ala town.

Daily Trust gathered that the body was found on Wednesday in Akpera suburb of Tongov community in Katsina -Ala area of the state.

Myaan was said to have been kidnapped over a month ago.
