Mob kills suspected robber in Yola

The police in Adamawa State, on Sunday, confirmed the killing by a mob of a suspected member of a criminal gang known as Shila Boys in Jimeta, headquarters of Yola North Local Government Area for allegedly robbing a lady.

The police spokesman, DSP Sulaiman Nguroje, confirmed the incident to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) on Sunday.

Nguroje who said the incident occurred on Saturday at about. The other two gang members, 7.pm, told NAN that three members of the gang were on a tricycle (Keke NAPEP) when they allegedly robbed the lady at Mubi Roundabout.

He explained that, "The lady (name withheld) shouted for help, and immediately a mob chased the suspects, caught

one of them and set fire on him. however, escaped."

He said from January 1 to date the command had recorded Three jungle justice incidents against the Shila Boys through mob attacks and therefore warned the people to desist from taking the law into their hands.
