Again, three killed in Ogun attack

① **G**unmen suspected to be herdsmen on Friday night, invaded Igbooro, Oja-Odan in Yewa-North Local Government Area of Ogun State, killing three and injured two villagers.

The killers reportedly invaded the village, close to Eggua in Oja-Odan around 11pm, sporadically and setting houses and stores in the village ablaze.

A mother and her child were among the three persons that were hacked to death in their huts while two persons were said to be in a critical condition

after they were shot by the attackers.

It was also learnt that many people, including children sustained varying degrees of injuries.

The attack came barely 24 hours after five persons were killed in Owode Ketu.

The Baale of Igbooro, Abidemi Akorede, said he had counted three corpses as of the time of speaking with our correspondent yesterday.

When contacted, the Police Public Relations Officer in the state, Abimbola Oyeyemi confirmed the incident, adding that team of policemen has been drafted to the scene to ensure safety if lives and property.
