1 Killed, 18 Abducted, Scores Injured As Bandits Strike In Niger Again

At least one person died, 18 kidnapped, while many others sustained various degrees of injury when bandits attacked the people of Kapana in Munya Local Government Area of Niger State.

According to sources, the bandits stormed the community Tuesday night, shooting sporadically.


