60 buried as death toll in Zamfara attacks rises

The death toll from the Wednesday's attacks on 13 communities in Zamfara State by armed bandits has risen to 60, residents told Daily Trust.

So far, 60 bodies have buried.

Other victims' bodies have not been recovered as relations fear that the assailants are lurking around the villages.

Some of the casualty figures, according to residents, are Kangan Farimana village, 11; Ruwan Dawa, 21; Madaba, 9; Arzikin Da, 6; Mai rai rai, 2; Gidan Maza, 1; Unguwa Malam, 1; Katohin, 1; Mai Aya Aya, 1; Kunkelai, 2; Mai Kogo, 2; Gobirawa, 2; Ruwan Rana, 1.

"We buried seven of the victims here in Magami. There are some individuals that are still missing and nobody knows whether they were killed or not," a resident, Halliru Bala, said.
