2 nabbed over killing of siblings in Aba

Abia State Police Command has confirmed the arrest of two persons, Chukwuebuka Nnamani and Temple Amanna in connection with the murder of two siblings.

The deceased siblings, Bright and Victory Osuagwu were killed last Friday in Osisioma Local Government Area of Abia State.

The police spokesperson in the state, Geoffrey Ogbonna, said Nnamani's arrest followed an unbelievable train of events.

Ogbonna said the shock caused by the killing of their children sent Mr. Osuagwu

and his wife to the hospital emergency ward and their apartment was without anybody.

He said the situation paved the way for one of the conspirators, Amanna, who lived in the neighbourhood, to rob their house.

He said Amanna was arrested by the neighbours and he confessed that they were paid N80, 000 to kill the two Osuagwu boys.

He led the neighbours to arrest his co-conspirator and both were handed over to the police, the police PRO said.

He said the police have launched a full investigation into the incidence.
