

Bandits kill two in Kaduna community

Bandits have killed two persons in Makoro Iri village in Kajuru Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

According to security reports, the bandits invaded the remote

village and shot dead the duo identified as Gideon Mumini and Barnabas Ezra.

The Commissioner, Internal Security and Home Affairs, Samuel Aruwan, disclosed this in a statement issued on Sunday.

In another development, troops of Operation Safe Haven have rescued three travellers

from armed bandits along the Gidan Waya-Godogodo road in Jema'a LGA.

The travellers were abducted by bandits who barricaded the road.

Troops responded to a distress call and pursued the bandits, rescuing the commuters.

The rescued travellers' vehicle, a Peugeot 307, was also recovered.

Governor Nasir El-Rufai noted with sadness the report of the attack in Makoro Iri village of Kajuru LGA, and prayed for the repose of the victims' souls, as he sent condolences to their families.
