

Imo Police kill 'wanted' armed robber that killed inspector

The Police in Imo have killed a notorious armed robber, Modestus Ugwuoha a.k.a Modukpe, that had been terrorising residents of Obiakpo community in Ohaji Egbema Local Government Area of Imo State.

A statement signed by the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), CSP Mike Abattam, said that the police tactical team acting on information swooped on the hideout of the gang that had killed a police Inspector at Njaba Police Station

The statement said, on approaching

the terror camp, the hoodlums on sighting the command's tactical teams shot at them, and there was exchange of gun fire. Due to the superior firing power of the police, two of the hoodlums were neutralised while others escaped into the bush with bullet wounds. The gun of the neutralised hoodlums was recovered - a locally made double barrel pump action gun.

"The community

went on jubilation on hearing of the death of the two terror gangs. They identified him to be Modestus Ugwuoha a.k.a "Modukpe", an escapee from Imo Correctional Centre, Owerri; an exconvict and the leader of the terror gang that have been violently robbing and raping women in their community. While the other one was said to be one of his vicious gang member."
