

## Four killed, one injured in fresh Plateau attack

At least four members of Irigwe ethnic group were killed on Tuesday with one other injured in two separate attacks in Bassa Local Government Area of Plateau State.

The first attack occurred along Twin Hill Road, while the second one occurred at a farm, all in Jebbu Miango District.

The Police Public Relations Officer in the state, Ubah Gabriel, who confirmed the incident, said two persons had died.

The attack came two days after a herder was shot dead at Kafigana in the Jebu District.

Malison Davidson, the spokesperson of Irigwe ethnic group in the state, told Daily Trust that the first two deceased were on their way from Jebbu Miango to Miango community when they were ambushed and killed while the other two were killed on the farms.

He said, "Three Rigwe people on a motorcycle have been ambushed around 6:50 pm this evening, Tuesday, September 28,2022 along Twin Hill Road, Jebbu Miango, Miango District of Rigwe Chiefdom, Bassa LGA of Plateau State.

"Two died instantly and sustained one gunshot injury and have been taken to a hospital for treatment. motorcycle has also been burnt down. The same evening, two persons were killed on the farm. include; The victims Bitrus Bulus, 45, Yakubu Chohu, 35, Friday Gani Kyrie, 33, Kyeri Gani, 19 while Musa Wah, 27 was injured.
