Son kills dad over farmland in Gombe

32-year-old man killed his father on Saturday at Zange village in Dukku Local government Area of Gombe State over a farmland.

A source said the son, Haruna Buba, committed the murder following a disagreement he had with

his elder brother, while accusing their father of allocating a bigger farmland to the elder brother.

The father, Habu Kuppe, a septuagenarian, was said to have come to intercede in the quarrel between the siblings when Haruna cut him on the head and back with a machete; killing him instantly.

City News learnt that after killing his father, Haruna left for a viewing centre in the village, from where he was arrested by Neete to death over a the police.

When contacted, the police spokesman the state, Mallum Buba, confirmed the incident, saying the suspect would be charged to court after investigation.
