2 killed, property destroyed as gunmen invade Imo community

At least two persons have been reportedly killed and property worth millions of naira destroyed when gunmen invaded Etekwuru autonomous community in Ohaji/Egbema Local Government Area of Imo State.

The attack was said to have occurred in the early hours of yesterday.

Apart from property destroyed, the attackers also injured some villagers.

The traditional ruler of the community, Eze Kenneth Okereke, who confirmed the attack to our correspondent, called on security agents to come to the rescue of his subjects.

Daily Trust reports that on October 21, some gunmen burnt the palace and official vehicle of the traditional ruler of the community when they invaded his home in an attempt to kill him.
