Man dies after falling from 2-storey building while asleep in Kwara

A middle-aged man said to be in his 30's simply identified as Dauda has died after falling from a twostorey building while asleep in his residence in Kwara State.

The incident, it was gathered, occurred at Ile Kolomo-nikoto, Itamerin area, Ilorin, on Friday.

The deceased, City & Crime exclusively gathered, was a spare parts dealer at Jengbe spare parts market, Ita-Nma, Ilorin West Local Government Area of the state.

Narrating the incident to our reporter, one of his colleagues, Alfa Abdul, said the late Dauda recently got his freedom and was managing with another colleague in the market before the incident.

"The house is a two-storey building and he went to a spot where they used to sleep at the top. Unfortunately, he fell from the building.

"They tried to rush him to the hospital but he was already dead. He has since been buried according to Islamic rites", the colleague added.

However, one of his neighbours, who gave another narrative of the incident, said the deceased was a drunkard.

"The victim was a drunkard and had gone to the Ile Ajibaye compound of the same Area after being drunk.

"He was escorted home but later went on top of the floor of the building which had no barrier where he slept off. Some people in the house heard a sound in the night of something that fell but didn't know he was the one.

"It was the following morning, while going for dawn (fajr) prayer, that we met him dead in a pool of blood", the neighbour who confided in Daily Trust added.

It was gathered that the leadership of the spare parts market didn't open for business to mourn him until Saturday afternoon.

One of the zonal chairmen in the market, Baba Musa, confirmed the incident when contacted on Tuesday.

He described the incident as an "unfortunate experience for all of us".
