

Rusticated student arrested over murder in Lagos

Detectives attached to the Lagos State Police Command have arrested a 300 level student identified as Ibrahim Ganiyu over his involvement in various murder cases around Amukoko and Orile areas of the state.

The suspect, according to the police, had been involved in several violent attacks in the area.

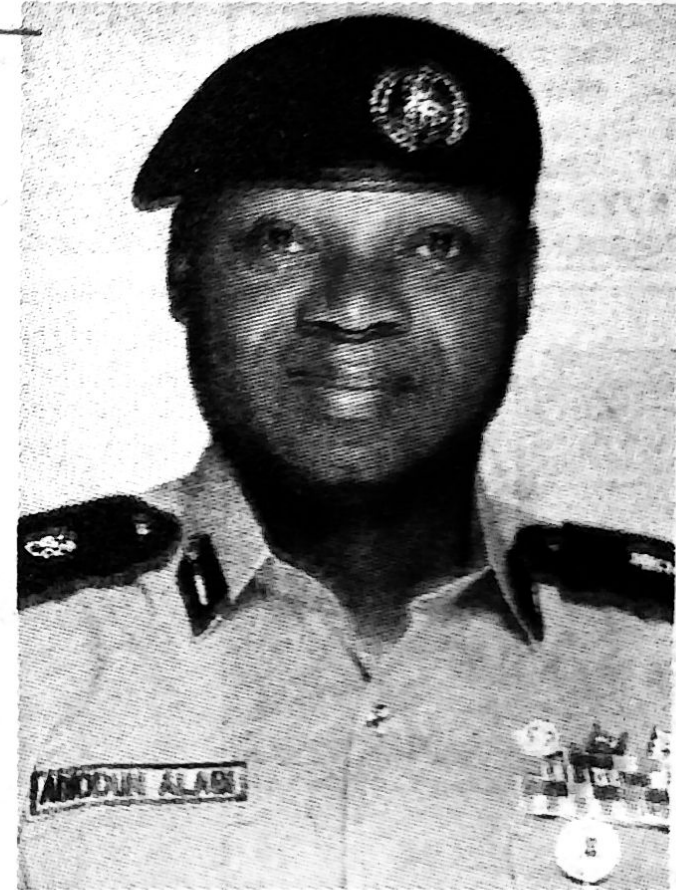
The police described him as a staunch member of the Eiyé confraternity terrorizing Amukoko, Orile and environs.

It said the suspect was a rusticated 300 level student of

Kwara State University, Ilorin and that he had been involved in a series of cult-related killings in the area.

Aside from cultism, the suspect is said to be involved, along with other hoodlums in "traffic robbery" around Marine Bridge and Amukoko area of the state.

Lagos State Police Commissioner, Adekunle Ajisebutu, who confirmed the arrest, said the suspect was apprehended in Gidan Drama, Marine Bridge, Lagos in possession of two locally made, cut-to-size single barrel pistols and two unexpended cartridges.
