

# Abiodun orders probe as building collapses, kills 2 in Ogun

**T**he Ogun State governor, Dapo Abiodun, has ordered an immediate investigation into the collapse of a building at his hometown, Iperu in Ikenne Local Government Area of the state.

A one-storey building along Ogere road in had collapsed, killing two people on Thursday.

A statement issued on Saturday in Abeokuta by the governor's chief

press secretary, Kunle Somorin, said Abiodun had constituted a four-man-team comprising the commissioner for physical planning, Tunji Odunlami; special adviser on environment, Ola Oresanya; special adviser bureau of lands and survey, Ololade Salami, and the commissioner of police, Mr Lanre Bankole.

The team, according to the statement, was mandated to look into the remote and immediate causes of the building collapse and

report back in one week.

While commiserating with the families of the deceased for the unfortunate loss of their loved ones, Abiodun assured that anyone found guilty of or culpable in the incident would be dealt with according to the law.

"No one who violates the building codes or regulations in the state will be allowed to go scot-free. Such person or persons will be made to face the full wrath of the law," the governor stated.
