2 Killed As Robbers Raid Dangote Refinery In Lagos

Dare devil armed robbers on Monday raided the Dangote Refinery in Lekki area of Lagos.



But in a swift reaction, the police authorities claimed that it foiled the attack.

President Muhammadu Buhari penultimate Tuesday commissioned the Dangote fertiliser plant also located at Lekki.

Lagos Police Public Relations Officer, Benjamin Hundeyin, in a statement, confirmed the attack.

He said security operatives in the early hours of Monday, March 28, 2022, foiled an attempted attack on Dangote Refinery, Lekki Free Trade Zone, Lagos.

Hundeyin said armed hoodlums numbering about 20 gained access to the refinery through the lagoon side.

He said the armed men were repelled while they attempted to cart away already-installed armoured cables in the refinery.

He said the hoodlums on sighting security operatives fled the scene and that one of the hoodlums was hit in the ensuing gunfire and died on the way to the hospital.
