Sources from Jere town said, yesterday, that the incident happened when the bandits stormed the residence of one Alhaji Awu at Ariko village in an attempt to abduct him. He was said to have resisted the bandits following which they dragged him out of the compound.

Narrating the incident to *Daily Trust*, a relative of Alhaji Awu who craved anonymity said Awu's younger brother had rushed out of his room on hearing the altercation with the bandits adding that "as soon as he stepped out of his room, they shot him dead. Alhaji's eldest son who also came out of his room was shot by the bandits.

"They forcefully took Alhaji Awu and two of his children a male and female away. The bandits laughed as they watched Alhaji Awu's wife hugged her son in the pool of his blood," he said

while the father and two others are still in captivity.
