Police arrest 3 over death of Bauchi APC LG chair

death the Gwabba, the statement said police received information Saturday that Gwabba was in distress.

"DPO C Division visited the scene at Khairan Hotel located Specialist behind Hospital Bauchi where he met the victim and rushed him to ATBU Teaching Hospital Bauchi treatment, where he was certified dead by a medical doctor.

"Preliminary investigation led to the arrest of three suspects interrogation"

He said the result of autopsy is the being awaited and the outcome of the investigation will be public," the made statement added.
