

Police arrest officers for shooting soldier

The Adamawa State commissioner of police, Sikiru Kayode Akande has ordered for the arrest of some police officers over a clash between them and soldiers which caused the death of a soldier.

Daily Trust learnt a disagreement between some policemen and soldiers working on Sunday at a check point along Numan Road on the outskirts of Yola degenerated in to a clash in which a police man shot a soldier to death.

A press release issued by the Police Public Relations Officer at the Adamawa State Command, DSP Sulaiman Nguroje said all police men suspected to have been involved were recalled to the headquarters and arrests were made.

The statement warned that the command would not tolerate conflict with members of sister organisations, saying the command held lives of all security personnel as sacrosanct, and culprits would be punished according to the law.
