2 women killed in Niger auto crash

Two women were killed on Thursday in a ghastly car crash around Mallam Karo, Suleja-Lambata Road, about 6kms to Kwamba park.

phone that the lone
crash involved a Mazda

car with ash colour and registration number ZAR-141-TD.

He said the accident involving the vehicle with three women and a man, which took off from Zaria, Kaduna State to Minna, Niger State, was caused by overspeeding and loss of control.

The Sector Commander said both the injured and the corpses of the two women who died were taken to Suleja General Hospital.
