

Woman's corpse discovered in Lagos guest house

2 The police in Lagos State have said that the manager of a guest house at the Igbogbo area of Ikorodu has discovered the corpse of a woman in one of the rooms on Saturday.

Police spokesman in the state, SP Benjamin Hundeyin, explained that the manager's report at the Ikorodu division indicated that the woman, who was about 46 years old, arrived at the guest house on a motorcycle rode by her companion, identified as Alfa Sule, on Friday.

He said that the manager reported that Alfa Sule of unknown address lodged at the guest house with the woman, later identified simply as Muinat.

He further said, "There are no marks of violence on the corpse. The said Alfa Sule is nowhere to be found, but he abandoned his Bajaj motorcycle.

"The police visited the scene and found the corpse with foam oozing out of its nostrils.

"Photographs of the scene and body were taken before the corpse was removed and deposited at the Ikorodu General Hospital for autopsy."

He added that the manager was assisting the police in their investigation while effort was on to arrest the fleeing Alfa Sule. (NAN)
