

Buni mourns with victims of Yobe road crash, inferno

Yobe State Governor Mai Mala Buni, has mourned the three persons who died and six others who sustained injuries in a road accident along the Potiskum-Bauchi Road.

Governor Buni who described the accident as shocking said the deaths and injuries were quite disturbing but that was their appointed time by the will of Almighty Allah.

Buni in a statement issued by his Director-General, Press Affairs and Media, Alhaji Mamman Mohammed

prayed to Allah to forgive their shortcomings, grant them Aljannatur Firdausi, and to their families, the fortitude to bear the loss.

The governor also prayed for quick recovery of those who suffered injuries and are now receiving treatment.

In another development, the governor commiserated with the victims of fire disaster in Sabon Pegi area of Damaturu metropolis.

Governor Buni described the incident, which affected some shops as very unfortunate.

"It is sad and most unfortunate that the victims lost their wares to the inferno," he said, calling on the people to always take measures against possible cases.

Governor Buni also commiserated with the family, people of Nangere local government and the Christian community over the death of Baba Ayuba Hamma Degubi JP.

He prayed to God to console the family to bear the irreparable loss of the elder and community leader.
