It was gathered that one of the party chieftains was at the collation centre with a retinue of aides in his bid to allegedly change the election results.

The duo was said to have engaged in an altercation which almost led to exchanging of blows, while presenting their complaints before the electoral officers at the collation centre.

"In the process, the supporters of both political chieftains started throwing stones at each other, and a security operative who was on electoral duty at the collation centre was hit, and he fired his gun.

"Yet, another version said while the security operatives were dispersing the irate electorate at the collation centre, the young man allegedly threw a stone at a security officer, who shot and killed the man," another source said.

The deceased, said to be an orphan, has since been buried at Ogbogbo, his ancestral home in Igalamela/Odolu local government.

The Kogi State Police Command's Public Relations Officer (PPRO), SP William Aya, did not respond to call and text message to that effect.
