

35 killed in 2 auto crashes in Kebbi – FRSC

Thirty-five persons were killed in two auto crashes that occurred in Kebbi State on Sunday and Monday.

FRSC's Sector Commander in the state, Mr Yusuf Aliyu-Haruna, told NAN in Birnin Kebbi on Tuesday that 40 other persons sustained varying degrees of injury in the accidents.

④ He said, "Twelve persons lost their lives in the accident that occurred on Kalgo-Bunza Road on Sunday involving two vehicles.

⑤ "On Monday, 23 persons lost their lives while travelling in a truck carrying assorted grains from Illela to Ibadan on Jega-Koko Road.

"Injured victims were taken to general hospitals in Kalgo and Jega LGAs."

Aliyu-Haruna attributed the accidents to overloading, over-speeding and use of expired tyres.
