## 4 killed in Yobe auto crash

No fewer than four people were killed while seven were hospitalised in Damaturu, the Yobe State capital, after a car rammed into pedestrians.

The incident, which happened on Friday night around 8.30pm on Gashua Road involved a Mercedes wagon.

An eyewitness who doesn't want to be mentioned said the driver of the car hit the victims while they were sitting on a table close to a shop.

According to him, the accident happened as a

result of over speeding and when the driver approached the victims, he tried to negotiate but lost control of the car and hit them.
