he Kwara State Police Command has arraigned a native doctor, Kolawole

Idowu, for allegedly killing a claims to be a medical doctor, was pregnant woman, Bilikis Ayinde, and her baby in Ilorin, Kwara

The doctor, according to the police report,

remanded alongside his cohort, Ibrahim Taiwo, the deceased woman's husband.

The police report indicated that one Yusuf Ajarat invited the native

doctor to ascertain the deceased's delivery date.

The report reads in part: "But the doctor injected her with oxytocin ergometrine, the injection that eventually caused her death."

Magistrate Adenike Abioye ordered the remand of the native doctor and the deceased's husband.

She released Ajarat on bail for being a nursing mother and adjourned to July 27, 2023.
