Fire service recovers woman's body from river

The corpse of an unidentified woman has been recovered by the men of the Kwara State Fire Service from Asa River, along Emir Road in Ilorin, the state capital.

It was gathered that the deceased, said to be about 46 years old, was discovered at about 6.44pm on Thursday.

Speaking with our correspondent

yesterday, spokesman of the state Fire Service, Hassan Adekunle, said the body has been deposited at the morgue of the University of Ilorin Teaching Hospital (UITH).

Adekunle said a police officer, SP Dolapo of 'B' Division Police Station, Ilorin, alerted the fire service about the incident.

While thanking the police officer for the promptness in reporting that case, Adekunle explained that the joint effort highlights the significance of interagency cooperation in dealing with emergencies effectively.

"The director of the Fire Service, Prince Falade John Olumuyiwa, was personally present at the scene. Olumuyiwa expressed sadness over the incident and advised the general public to be more vigilant in their neighbourhoods to prevent similar occurrences," he said.
