ISWAP kill 4 policemen, cart away cache

① Suspected fighters of the Islamic State of West Africa Province (ISWAP) have attacked a police station in Borno State, sources said.

The attack happened when ISWAP fighters stormed the police station at about 10.30pm on Friday night at Gajiram

town, Nganzai Local Government Area and opened fire on the policemen on duty, killing at least four while unspecified number were wounded.

The local vigilante said about four policemen were killed and a cache of ammunition carted away during the attack.

"We found four policemen dead and some are yet to return as we speak," a

vigilante source said.

A top security source said the invaders had wreaked havoc and left the scene before military reinforcement arrived. "Yes, when we got the report, our troop mobilised and moved to the scenes unfortunately the invaders had run away."

As of the time of filing this report, the police were yet to issue any statement on the incident.
