

# Man strangled, thrown on Kano street

A yet to be identified man has been found 'strangled' and thrown on a street in Kano.

The man, was found at State Road just a few metres away from the state government house.

According to witnesses, the man was suspected to be strangled with a cable by unknown thugs and was struggling to be alive.

He was, however, rushed to the Muhammad Abdullahi Wase Teaching Hospital (MAWTH) for urgent medical attention.
