One killed as hoodlums attack NDLEA office in Bayelsa

The corpse of a youth Moses identified as Thursday Akada was discovered at the Bayelsa State Headquarters of the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) after some youths suspected to be cultists and drug dealers stormed vandalised office, the operational vehicles and freed the arrested suspect.

Daily Trust observed that the NDLEA operatives had on Wednesday arrested a female drug trafficker in Yenizue-Epie community in Yenagoa LGA where they were attacked by some youths of the communities.

However, the NDLEA officers were able to arrest a suspect identified as Abraham Aderin, who allegedly incited the mob.

Confirming the incident, the NDLEA Public Relations Officer in Bayelsa, said in a statement on Thursday that the lifeless body of the deceased had already been deposited at the Federal Medical Centre, Yenagoa, pending investigation into the real cause of his death.
